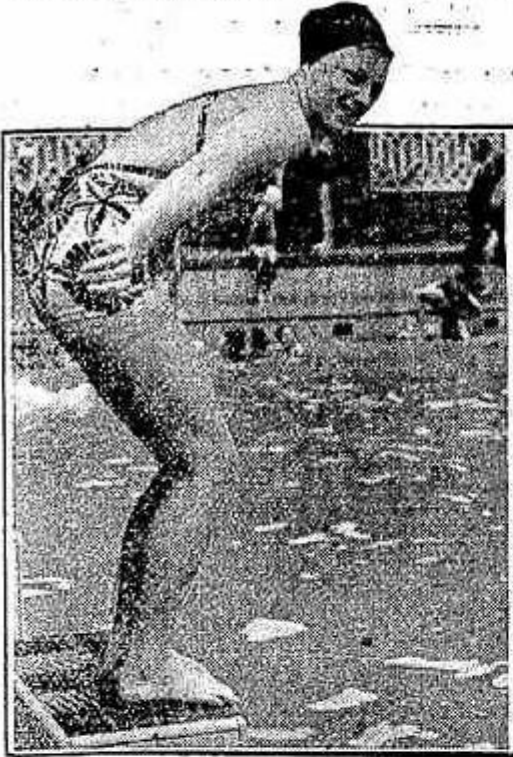

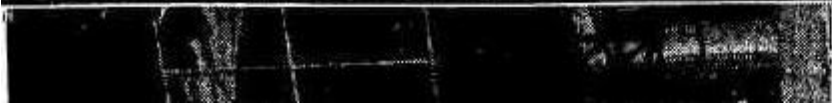


CANADA HAS NOTHING CUTER than pretty Noel Oxembury, who is well in the swim.





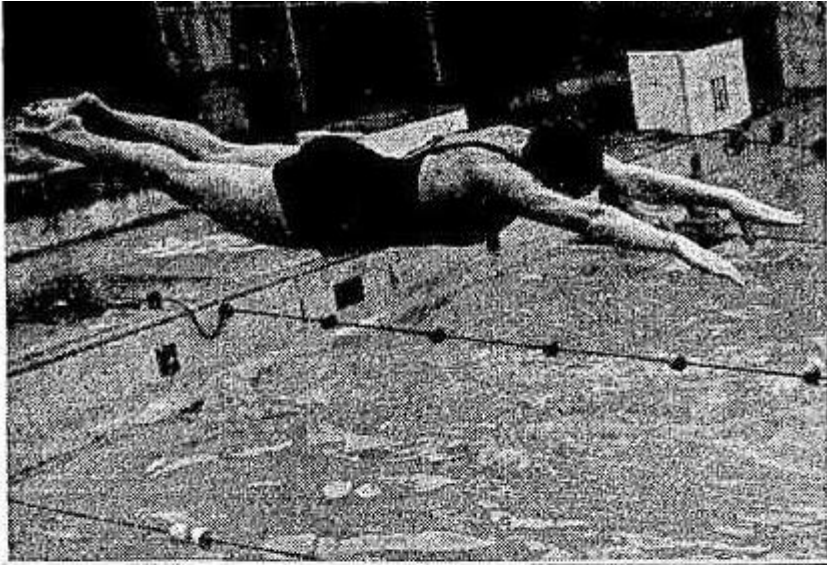
**UP AND OVER IN PERFECT HORIZONTAL
